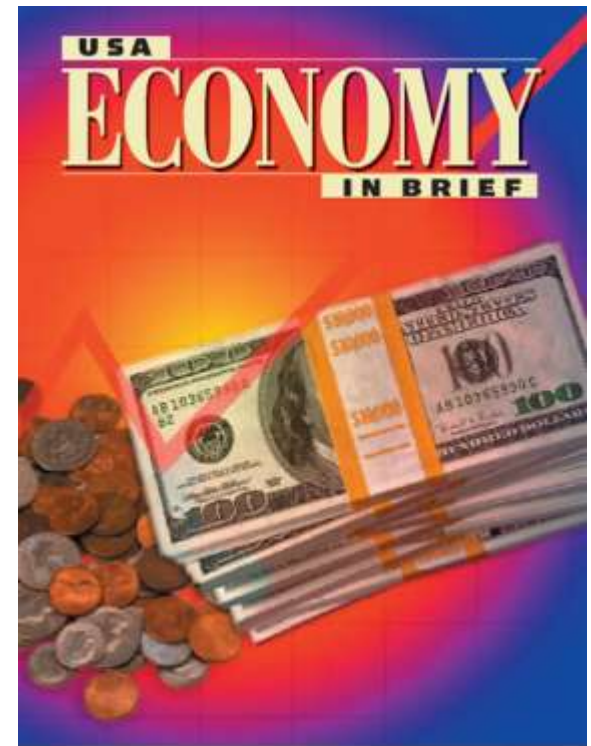

What do they use for money?

What can you buy here?

How much does it cost?

- In the US, an iPod Touch would cost \$229 for 8 GB
- An 16 GB would cost \$299, and the 32 GB would cost \$399



National debt

What does their gov. spend money on?

- Right now, the US have an amount of national debt of \$11.5 trillion
- The US government spend this money on healthcare, education, aid to low-income or unemployed, and infrastructure investment

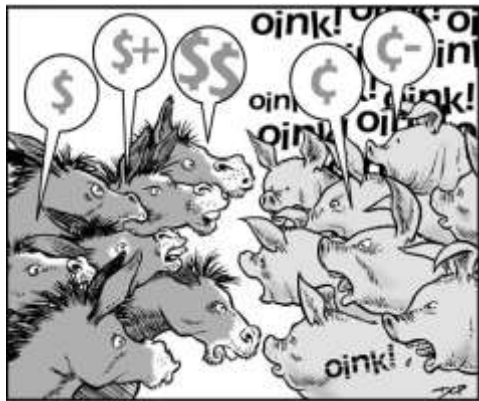

What are wages like in US for a regular job?

- In the US, the federal minimum wage from \$5.15 an hour to \$7.25 an hour by August 2009.



China



What do they use for money?

Yuan



What can you buy there? How much does that cost?

- In China, an iPod touch would cost 2,698 Yuan for 80G and 3,598 Yuan for 160G.
- That is approximately \$ 395 for an 80 GB and \$526.7 for an 160 GB



National debt

What does the gov. Spend money on?

- China have a total of 18.23 trillion yuan in national debt is approximately equal to 2.23 trillion USD
- The China government spend their money on housing, rural development, major infrastructure, healthcare and education.



What are wages like in China for a regular job?

- In China, the highest salary for one month is ¥25.80 or ¥4.66 equal to \$0.60 an hour.
- The lowest salary for a whole month worth is ¥20.70 per month or ¥0.69 or \$0.25 an hour.

- One major common difference between China and the US is the **POPULATION**.
- 1.3 billion Chinese compare to 300 million Americans
